## Trash Routes and Information

### Tuesday, Trash 1 (T-1)

South Side of Route 70, Chestnut Street, Manapaqua Avenue, Rose Street, Lilac Street, Lake Street, and Barker's Village

### Thursday, Trash 2 (T-2)

North Side of Route 70, All Westlake Area, Maple Street, Oak Street, Poplar Street, Willow Street, Pinehurst Estates, and Lakehurst Moblie Home Park


- If your trash/recycling collection day falls on a holiday, it will be rescheduled to Wednesday of that same week.
- Garbage containers must be less than 50 pounds .
- Metal objects will be collected on the first and third Friday. Refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, propane tanks, and tires are all subject to a disposal fee. Payment must be made at the Borough Hall Business Office or at the Public Works Office. Payment receipt must be presented at the Public Works Garage when disposing of item. Any gasoline powered equipment will not be collected unless drained of all fluids.
- Wood must be cut into four foot lengths and tied.
- Furniture will be collected on regular trash days, with a maximum of two pieces per collection. Please limit amount of non-household garbage put out. Excessive construction debris and whole-house cleanouts will require a dumpster.

Residents are reminded to place their trash or recyclables curbside on the previous night to avoid missing collection.  
Do not put trash or recyclables out sooner than the evening before collection day.



# Single Stream Recycling Information


- Curbside recycling collection will be on Monday for all areas. If a holiday falls on a Monday, recyclables will be collected on Wednesday.
- Recyclables collected curbside must be placed “loose” into your can. Never contain bottles, cans, and pour-able plastics in plastic bags. Remember place rinsed food container cans, glass bottles, and plastic bottles/jars (neck of the plastic being smaller than the base), newspapers, corrugated cardboard, magazines, catalogs, junk mail, paperback books, and empty non-toxic aerosol cans **ONLY** into your recycling can loose—do not place recyclables in any type of bag.
- Plastic bags should be returned to local supermarkets, where they will be recycled by the store.

## Additional Disposal Information

- **All visitors entering the fenced area of Public Works MUST sign in at the front office**
- Hazardous materials will not be accepted at the Public Works Garage. Please call the Ocean County Northern Recycling Center at 732-367-0802 for more information.
- Saturday disposal information: The Public Works Garage will be open on the second Saturday of each month as follows:
  - April through October - 7:00 am to 3:00 pm**
  - November through March - 8:00 am to 12:00 noon**
- Acceptable items for Saturday disposal are: leaves, furniture, asphalt, brush, debris, bricks, dry paint cans, wood, concrete and metal.
- Christmas Trees will be collected on Fridays in January.
- E-Waste must be brought down to the Public Works Garage.
